### GENERAL INFORMATION:

- The program provides care for children from Prep to Grade 6.
- Only full day care is available. There is a maximum of 30 places per day.
- Please dress children appropriately – shoes with closed in toes, tops with sleeves, and with a jacket or warm top.
- Children need to bring morning and afternoon tea, lunch, and a water bottle.
- Children must be signed in on arrival and signed out when collected by an authorised person.
- Children need to take responsibility for any toys etc they bring to the program. Time periods will be set aside when children can use their electronic games. At other times they should be stored in bags.
- Each day will have indoor and outdoor activities, and children will need to be suitably clothed to go outside.

### BOOKINGS:

- Bookings accepted now, and must be confirmed with payment.
- Cost is \$35 a day. This can be reduced considerably with CCB.
- Casual bookings can be accepted if there are still vacancies.
- Absences: there is no refund for booked days missed unless you have a medical certificate. If children are absent you may switch to another day within this program if places are available.
- Please notify any absences before 9.00am

## HOLIDAY PROGRAM

**Monday 21<sup>st</sup> September: Let's Go to the Show:** It's show time in Melbourne, so let's make our own show. We can make show bags, some side shows, displays of animals, crafts, fashion, food stalls, and anything else we can think of.

**Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> September: Baking Day:** Cakes, biscuits, bread, damper, muffins, scones. Let's try them all, and then ice some of them. Please bring a container that you can take some of the goodies home in.

**Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> September: Wheels:** Bring a set of wheels with you – a bike, scooter or roller skates – and some safety gear! We will design a track and give you lots of time to ride. We will also make toys with wheels, make car race tracks, make box cars, and lots more.

**Friday 25<sup>th</sup> September: Grand Final Day:** Dress in your favourite team's colours, play some football, make some hotdogs, make some team posters or streamers, make up some cheer leading chants.

**Monday 28<sup>th</sup> September: Games Day:** Play lots of games inside and outside. There will be lots of old favourites and some new games. There will also be the opportunity to make up your own games.

**Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> September: Craft Day:** Let's make lots of jewellery, puppets, cushions, toys, books, wooden things, animals, key tags, book marks, money boxes, or anything else you would like.

**Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> September: Baking Again:** Once again we will try lots of baking – and take home some of the goodies. If you have an apron, it would be a good idea to bring it to keep your clothes clean.

**Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> October: Movies:** We'll set up a movie theatre and watch some movies. We'll have some pop corn to munch on, and time to play plenty of games as well.

**Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> October: Artists at Work:** Painting, drawing, collage, modelling, sculpture, cartoons, patterns, photography. I have some art smocks, but it would be good if you can bring your own on this day.

**Every day:** There will be lots of games, both indoors and outdoors, art activities, music, DVDs Lego, Nintendo, crafts, quiet times, and of course time to eat snacks and lunch!
